<u>Partnership with towns.</u> River Access Committee. Meetings continue with Canton. Canton BOS approved River Access Committee report that included FRCC funding two additional positions for Stewards to include all Canton locations. All minutes and recordings are on the Town of Canton website under Meetings, Agendas.

<u>Groundworks Bridgeport</u> No further info provided.

<u>Kiosks</u> Lengthy discussion on design, materials, estimated costs. Roger to research estimated costs with an acquaintance. Stephan advises that no additional panel design needs to be done – only need to know size of panel. There needs to be two panels to print for each kiosk. Sinish to request from Andrew what was paid for most recent panels. Recognizing that expense to completely replace all kiosks may be prohibitive. there needs to be agreement on which kiosks to replace. Much more research needs to be done.

Request from FALPS for \$900 to reprint trail maps. Voted unanimously to approve and recommend to next Full Meeting.
