Approval of November Minutes

TREASURERS REPORT

- New dollars for FY24 are incorporated into balance.

- Expect funding to be similar next year for FY25
 - Begin thinking of budget needs and projects for next year. New workplans and budgets need to be submitted in March.

EXECUTIVE SUBCOMITTEE

- Andrew will recirculate notes from September meeting with ACOE
- Q's for USACE in January
 - O What are the avenues for a short-term solution?
 - What options does USACE have to improve consistency of flow?
 - Are there proactive approaches?
 - o Can you give us an example of dams that do more than flood control?
 - Any capital improvements on Colebrook that could effect flow?
 - Can you explain the communication process between MDC and USACE?
 - o How can a group like FRCC help in this process?
- Could we update the river economics study? Flow study?
 - River flow working group will explore possibilities and budget range

RESOURCE STEWARDSHIP

- Water quality monitoring is underway.
- FRCC received a thank you note from NHLT for \$1500 for further land acquisition assistance.

- Culvert training coming up for towns
- October 28, TU met with FRWA at 532 Hogback Rd culvert to discuss how to remove barrier to flow. TU will draft designs to improve connectivity.
- West River Rd Project no updates though some concern about completing project before June 30 deadline after which funding will expire.
- FALPS submitted \$10k grant request for tree planting. Resource Stewardship will review.

EDUCATION & OUTREACH

- Junior Ranger Books update underway. Laura, Stephan, and Andrew are revising and will consider sending to graphic designer or redesigning in house. Printing likely to be done by NPS.
- Kiosks Canton panel is being worked on. Stephan is updating map. Sarah Faulkner working with Conservation Commission to develop back panel info. Front Panel will be FRCC W&S.
 - o Mary Crombie retiring, will need to find new designer in future.
- Informational one-pager regarding river flow. Draft under review: comments welcome.
 - o Aiming for more "info graphic" than winding explanation.

Reps expressed need for new signs at monofilament receptacles along the river. Will be addressed by E&O in coming months.
