Agenda:

1. Invasive Species Management

Christian Allyn is scheduled to talk to FRCC via Zoom on February 24 during the regular meeting. The committee thinks it is a good idea to invite local land trust/conservancies to attend the presentation.

2. Water Quality Monitoring

Water quality reports and graphs for 2024 will be presented in the March meeting.

Winter water quality monitoring is ongoing for chloride, conductivity and temperature.

3. Land Protection/Grants

The town of Hartland has requested **\$4476** for the Natural Resources Inventory. They will contract to have a series of maps that will be updated from the past NRI and new materials will be created. Lists of plants and wildlife will be created and/or updated. Roger B. moved to approve that proposal and Alison M. seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Carole Cheah submitted a request for **\$12,625** to continue treatment for HWA. Laura H. moved to approve and Jim B. seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.

Carole Cheah submitted a grant request for **\$1,500** to submit a peer-review journal publication about the HWA control in the Wild & Scenic stretches. Alison M. moved to approve and Laura seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Culverts

Ratlum Brook Culverts were surveyed by FRWA. FVTU members, Jim B and Tom C. did a stream walk. Severe barriers were encountered. The next step is to hold a meeting with all parties.
